## Upcoming Public Meeting for Zoning

Zoning will become a reality in AH soon. Mandatory public information meetings are scheduled for Flinton, Friday July 14 at the Municipal Office (Open house 4-7 p.m., public meeting 7 p.m.) and Denbigh, Saturday July 15 at the Township Hall (Open house 2-4 p.m., public meeting 4 p.m.).

The Zoning by-law will provide regulations for land use which implement the policies of the Official Plan. The regulations will create various land use zones and provide direction for building and development by establishing permitted uses, required lot sizes and frontages, development setbacks, etc.

Text and map schedules will be available for viewing at the Open Houses. For more info contact Jack Pahl, Clerk.

## 2006 Municipal Election Notes

- Voter's list shall be available for revision, in the office of the Clerk, from Sept. 5 to the end of voting on Nov. 13, 2006;

- If the number of candidates nominated for office(s) exceeds the numbers required to be elected, as of 5 p.m. on October 5/06, a poll will be held;

- voting will be available 24 hours a day from Nov. 3 until 8 p.m. local time on Nov. 13/06 *via*

*toll free telephone, cell phone or internet, only. No mail-in or traditional voting will be used.*

- The offices for which persons may be nominated are: Reeve (1 – at large) Councillors, 2 each from Ward 1 and Ward 2, resp.

- If eligible voters have not received a “voter’s information letter” in the mail by October 30/06, they should contact the Township office *immediately*.

- N.B. If the status of any elector changes after June 30/06 (e.g. buys/sells qualifying property or changes a mailing address) it is imperative that those details are faxed or emailed to the Township ASAP. Failure to do so could affect timely delivery of a voting kit.

- N.B. Check the Twp. web page for enumeration information and election updates and tips on telephone or internet voting.

The Township has contributed towards the establishment of a new 600 km roadside cycling trail system! All trails are looping to enable you to return to your parked vehicle. They range in length from the easy 21 km White Lake route to the challenging 102 km, “leg burning” Buckshot Lake loop.

## Things to Know Before You Burn

Burning needs to be done with care from April 1 - Oct. 31st and only before 7 a.m. and after 7 p.m.

If a Fire Ban has been issued no burning of campfires or incinerators is allowed until the Ban is lifted. You can find out if a Fire Ban is in effect by calling the fire information phone line at 336-1851.

Ratepayers and visitors should know violators face significant fines. If a fire gets out of control the violators will be held accountable for all fire fighting costs associated with putting the fire out which can easily reach into the thousands of dollars! ## Hazardous Household Waste Disposal

Through an agreement with HHWD in Renfrew, Addington Highlands residents now have a place to dispose of their household hazardous waste, at no charge. The site is located at 376 Bruce Street, Renfrew.

Directions: If you are coming into Renfrew from Hwy 132 you will come to a T intersection at Lochiel Street. Turn left onto Lochiel, take your next left onto Stewart Street (HWY 60). Follow Stewart Street until you come to Bruce Street. Turn right on Bruce and follow until you reach the landfill site (on your left).

The HHWD is open from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. Tuesday to Saturday from May 20 until August 29, 2006.
